






# STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS






#### DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

## **ACADEMIC PROGRESS**


The academic goals of West Park Academy by the end of the 2022-23 school year were for:

- 75% of students to improve grade level appropriate math skills as measured by i-Ready Math Assessment


West Park Academy achieved both goals with 92% of students meeting expected growth in Reading and 84% of students meeting expected growth in Math.

St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance.
